11:11 MOOZZ MUSIC CONTEST

What does 11:11 mean?

We are looking for 1111 musicians; the contest is limited to that number of participants.

Where can I find more technical information about the stems?

After successfully registering as an artist, you will find video tutorials and detailed documentation in English and Spanish.

Can I upload stems I have created in the past?

Probably not because the structure may not fit. Additionally, the melodies may not fit our MIDI template, which can be found in the stem request to be downloaded. However, you may be able to customize the structure to fit our standard stem structure. Please check the documentation area after registering in the dashboard. It is very important that the content uploaded does not infringe on copyright. Artist is responsible for the content uploaded.

Are there any restrictions regarding the type of instruments, such as acoustic versus digital?

Artists enjoy complete freedom in their choice of instruments. However, it is essential to adhere to the guidelines and structure of the competition. The primary requirement is to ensure that the sound quality meets all necessary standards.

What are the criteria for winning?

There are two main criteria for determining the winners. Firstly, the overall quality of the uploaded stem is evaluated. Secondly, emphasis is placed on the aspects of rhythm and creativity. Participants can upload multiple stems to enhance their chances of winning.

Who will select the winners?

Initially, a shortlist of melodies will be curated by the Moozz team. Subsequently, these entries will be reviewed by a panel composed of three independent parties not affiliated with Moozz. They will vote to determine the top stems from the shortlist. Once the winner is chosen, it will be announced through our social media channels.

Can I play any melody and produce any length?

No, after registration, please refer to the Stems Request page to understand our specific requirements, including the BPM, musical key (template downloadable from the Stem Request page), required instruments, and style. The length of the stem must adhere to specified rules outlined in the Artist Area documentation available after registration. Additionally, the structure of the stem must follow set guidelines, all of which can be found in the documentation section of the website.

What are the minimum requirements for participation?

Registration is the initial step; however, it does not guarantee participation. To actively participate, you must upload stems in accordance with the provided instructions and guidelines. Our team will review the content submitted. You can monitor the status of your uploaded files through your Moozz's Dashboard. Only files meeting the criteria will be accepted for consideration. Stems or files that are rejected do not qualify for the contest.

Will I get automatic access to the beta app if I participate in the music contest?

Yes, by participating in the music contest, you will gain automatic access to the beta app, allowing you to explore and utilize the stems provided by producers worldwide. Access is granted solely to accepted content participants.

Where can I find stem examples uploaded by other artists?

After registration and login, please check the artist area. Here, you will be able to download music MIDI templates and stem demos. These resources allow you to import them into your DAW to examine the stem structure, audio format, length, and music template.
